BRIDGE CROWD SAW STEAMBOATS CRASH

There Was a Small Panic, but Little Damage—Cars Delayed by the Crowd.

While thousands of rush-hour travelers stood high above, on the middle span of the Brooklyn Bridge watching it, a collision occurred in mid-stream of East River to-day.

The steamer Pequonook ran afoul of the ferry-boat Somerset as the latter was making for her pier at the foot of Roosevelt street.

Thanks to this, there was no serious damage. The sides of the Somerset's paddle-box and the women's cabin were battered and a lot of window glass was shattered in the ferry-boat, but neither craft suffered any derangement of her steering gear or injury to her hull.

There was a small panic aboard the Somerset when those aboard felt the jarring blow of the steamboat, but the officers and the crew soon quieted the passengers.

Both boats were able to proceed after a minute or two.

The time on the bridge was tied up for a few minutes by the crowd that stopped to watch the sight.






