

HUGHES WINS BY 35,000 TO 40,000

UP-STATE CITIES FOR HEARST BY A SURPRISING VOTE

League Candidate Ran Best in Industrial Centres, Carrying Many Republican Strongholds.

Hearst's vote in the cities up State was a surprise. He ran strong in every city and carried Buffalo, Rome, Utica, Elmira and others. In those carried by Hughes the plurality was much less than that of Higgins two years ago.

HEARST WAS CONFIDENT OF HIS ELECTION

Declared He Had Won Just After Big Vote Up State Was Reported.

M'CLELLAN AND JEROME HEAR NEWS TOGETHER

Crowd of Notables at Police Headquarters to Get the Returns.

With satisfaction written all over his face Mr. Hearst left his house at 6.45 o'clock, just after the first complete returns came in from up-State cities, and with his wife and his lawyer, Clarence Shearn, went to the Cafe Martin, where he ate a hearty dinner.

Mayor McClellan, District-Attorney Jerome, Commissioner Bingham, and several other notables heard the returns at Police Headquarters. They had seats in the Commissioner's private office, while a lot of others received the reports in the trial room, which had been thrown open to the public.

HEARST CARRIES CITY BY 70,000; UP-STATE VOTE SWAMPS HIM

Figures Indicate that the Republican Vote Down to the Bronx Will Run from 105,000 to 115,000--Many Judiciary Ticket Wins.

With two-fifths of the State heard from outside the city, Hughes gets 293,509, Hearst 159,195. Same districts two years ago gave Higgins, Rep., 230,334; Herrick, Dem., 167,595.

This indicates that the State above the Bronx will give Hughes about 105,000 plurality, against the 160,000 that Higgins got.

In Greater New York, 270 Election Districts out of 1,487 give Hearst 51,962, Hughes 40,062.

This indicates that Hearst will carry Greater New York by about 71,000.

These figures would elect Hughes in the entire State by about 34,000.

GREAT CROWDS WATCH RETURNS

Enormous crowds gathered from the lower end of Broadway clear through to Harlem to witness the flashing of the returns on the huge sheets that made white patches on the face of the city at a hundred different points.

In Brooklyn, in Long Island City, Williamsburg and in the Bronx there were crowds packed thick and black in front of all the newspaper offices and the various political headquarters.

But it was on Broadway and notably at Park Row, at Herald Square and at One Hundred and Twenty-fifth street that the greatest, biggest, noisiest multitudes collected. Park Row, in front of the Pulitzer building, was black with people and vocal with the music of noisy tin horns and noisier human lungs long before the first news was flashed on the big white bulletin board of The Evening World.

GUILD BEATS MORAN IN BAY STATE FIGHT

BOSTON, Nov. 6.—The returns so far indicate the re-election of Gov. Curtis Guild, Jr. by a majority of about 30,000, or 5,000 more than he received a year ago. In Boston Guild received about the same vote as last year but gained in nearly every other part of the State, though Moran polled a heavier vote than did Bartlett last year.

ROCK A BADLY BEATEN MAN

Returns from ten of the seventy election districts in the Fourteenth Senate District give Grady 1,885, Rock 818. M'CARREN'S HIT AT HEARST. With returns from half of Brooklyn in, Patrick H. McCarren estimated that Hughes would carry Kings County by 5,000, he added.

REPUBLICANS CARRY VERMONT BY 5,000

CONCORD, N. H.—Charles M. Floyd, Republican, is elected Governor by more than 5,000 plurality.

MICHIGAN RE-ELECTS REPUBLICAN GOVERNOR.

DETROIT, Mich., Nov. 6.—Gov. Warner (Rep.) has carried by a majority of 617 the cities of Lansing, Hillsdale and Adrian, which he lost in 1904 by 372 votes. The vote is only about two-thirds that of 1904.

GOV. CUMMINS LOOKS LIKE IOWA WINNER.

DES MOINES, Ia., Nov. 6.—Iowa's vote for Governor is large. Cummins' plurality of 196 will be much reduced, but indications point to his election.
