

CAPS, NOT HELMETS, IS POLICE ORDER

Patrolmen Must Go on Duty Wearing New Headgear Beginning Thursday.

The 5,200 members of the police force of Greater New York will make their appearance Thursday in caps instead of helmets. They have been talking of this since the order was promulgated to them yesterday.


But Commissioner Bingham, who assumes full responsibility for the change, is obdurate, and as a result most of the members of the force have already purchased the new headgear. It was thought for a time that Deputy Commissioner Waldo got the idea of caps in Paris, but it is desired by friends of Commissioner Bingham that the Commissioner believe in caps because he is an army man, and for that reason ordered the change.

Few patrolmen could be found to-day who favored the innovation. The stiff helmets have been worn by them for many years, and in many instances have saved the wearers from injury and possible death. Besides, they do not think the caps look well, and a New York policeman is mighty particular about his looks. The patrolmen and roundsmen will pay \$2.50 for their caps and 75 cents for a rubber cover. The new gold braid on the sergeants' and captains' caps make the cost \$4 and \$5 respectively. The caps are blue, the same color as the uniform.

Patrolman Anton Andesner, of the Oak Street precinct, called the "Father of the Regiment," who has been on the force nearly thirty-two years, said: "I'd as soon wear the cap as the
