

VETERAN SHOT TO DEATH WHILE CROWD LOOKS ON

Victim and Slayer, Employees at Navy-Yard, Lived in Same House.

A dozen persons, men and women, standing at Myrtle avenue and Cumberland street, Brooklyn, last night waiting for a car, saw Daniel F. Coyle shoot and kill William Morton, a veteran of the Spanish war, both men were employed in the Navy-Yard and lived in the same house, No. 19 Carlton avenue. The assailant told the police of the Frushing Avenue station that he bought the revolver on the Bowery yesterday for the express purpose of killing Morton, because he said Morton had entered his room.

ONE BORE OF BELMONT TUNNEL IS PUT THROUGH

Workmen Go from Manhattan to Queens Under River.

One of the most remarkable engineering feats in the history of the city was accomplished when workmen were able to walk through the north tube of the Belmont tunnel from New York to Long Island City and back again last night.

Within a few minutes of 8 o'clock, the closing hour of the day's work, the foreman of the gang of laborers stood at the Manhattan side of the partition rock that alone divided the Long Island City and Manhattan boro.

And as the whistle sounded the hour five heavy strokes with picks made a hole through which the men on either side shook hands. Within five minutes the space had been cleared and the men were making their first under-the-river trip to Long Island City.

The announcement of the opening of the north tube was then flashed to Mr. Belmont.

It is sanguinely expected by the men in charge of the work that the north tube will be ready for railroad traffic on September 1. Three months or more must elapse, however, before the south tube can be bored through.
