

NATIONS' FLAGS FLY FOR PEACE AT THE HAGUE

Emblems of Every Civilized Country Are Raised in Honor of Conference.

THE HAGUE, June 14.—This city suddenly blossomed out with flags to-day, every civilized country on the globe hoisting its standard over the hotels and legations clustered about the two principal squares...

Practically all the missing delegations arrived during the day. The English, twenty-five strong, headed by Sir Edward Fry, Judge of the Chancery Division of the British High Court of Justice and member of the Permanent Court of Arbitration at The Hague...

The Germans, Italians and many South and Central Americans came by train. M. Nelidoff, head of the Russian delegation, after conferences with the leading plenipotentiaries and an examination of the text of the address which the Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Netherlands will deliver to-morrow...

Following the precedent established in 1892, the Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Netherlands, on the opening of the conference in the Hall of Knights to-morrow, will propose that the conference despatch a message of greeting and appreciation to Emperor Nicholas and in return M. Nelidoff will move a message of thanks for the hospitality of Queen Wilhelmina and the

Government of the Netherlands. W. H. de Beaufort, head of the delegation of the Netherlands, will propose that M. Nelidoff be elected President of the conference. After the inaugural session the entire delegation will make a tour of the Hall of Knights.

JAMESTOWN FAIR HAS ANOTHER HEAD

He was given concurrent authority with the Exposition governors, but in addition all differences between Barr and the governors are to be settled by a committee of three bankers here, and it was these three bankers who selected Barr for the place he to-day took. Barr's policy will be retrenchment in expenses, and particularly as to salaries. There is already talk to-day of resignations high and low, one of these being a member of the governing board.
