25,000 SEE TWO HORSES RACE FOR \$15,000 PRIZE.

Getaway Day Good Thing Master Robert, at Good Price, Captures the Third, Although Jockey Miller Complains of Foul Riding at the Turn.

BRIGHTON BEACH RACE TRACK, Aug. 3.—Charles Edward is a record breaker. He hung up his third new mark in winning the \$15,000 Brighton Derby, running the distance under a pull nearly all the way in 2:30.4-5. This not only beats the best track record of 2:32.1-5, made by Hermis in 1903 at Brighton, but it is close to the world's mark of Goodrich, at Chicago, 1898, 2:30.1-4. Goodrich, however, carried only 102 pounds, while Charles Edward packed 126.

Charles Edward made his other new mark in the same course on July 16, when he galloped home in the mile and an eighth Seagate Stakes in 1:03.5. In his previous start he made the remarkably fast time for the mile of 1:37.5, a new track record. This was in the Brighton mile on July 10.
