

CELLAR MYSTERY MAY BE CLEARED BY AN AUTOPSY

Strange Message of Florence Reynolds's Death Given in January.

An autopsy will be performed at the morgue in the hope that the cause of death may be discovered in the body of a woman found yesterday in a disused alcove in the cellar of the tenement at 147 East Thirtieth street.

The identification was made by James Duffy, a cigar-maker, of No. 612 Second avenue, who has been detained by the police until various points of the story which he tells are investigated.
