

DARING RESCUE OF BOY MADE BY TWO FIREFMEN

Swung Him From Blazing Room to Safety on Roof Across the Way.

THOUSANDS CHEER MEN.

Many Children in East Side Tenement Took to the Fire Escapes.

In the sight of a cheering audience that numbered thousands, two firemen worked a human bridge rescue to-day in a tenement house blaze on the east side that recalled the famous life-saving stunts of Capt. Vaughan in the Hotel Royal horror.

In plain sight of the packed street and before the eyes of the passengers on the "L" trains that sped by far below them, the plucky two hauled a helpless, half-suffocated youth out of a front window of No. 725 Third avenue, incidentally risking their own necks to do it.

The building is a five-story brick, occupied on the ground floor as a restaurant and on the other floors as living quarters for five or six families. The fire started under the basement stairs, and before anybody smelled the smoke it had shot up the stairs and was working its way toward the roof as fast as it could jump from one flimsy wooden handrail to another.

For the most part the occupants found escape shut off before the first alarm had been turned in. The firemen, the Hughes, the Nolans, big and little, but mainly little, and the Castles swarmed down the rear fire escapes and dropped uninjured, but badly scared, into the small courtyard at the back.

Engine Company No. 2, from around the corner in Fifth street were the first of the unimpeded forces to reach extension ladders at the front, not because there appeared to be any probability that the ladders would be needed, but as a matter of precaution.

Man in Blazing Room. Just then a cry went up from the crowd. A man had appeared at a front window on the top floor. He half fell across the sash, making gestures for help with his feebly waving arms, but apparently too far gone to yell. Smoke that was shot with a reddish tinge rolled out of the window, and the men at the cranks tried to swing the wavering extensor ladder. It jammed, and trying to start it again fireman Burns, of Engine Truck No. 1, who had just arrived, had his right index finger ground off.

Tom Dugan, a fireman of No. 2 Company, who lives at No. 217 West Forty-third street, and who was off duty, had been looting along the avenue, in citizen's clothing when the other boys called by him on their truck, and he had followed them.

Standing in the crowd, he saw that the roof of No. 725 being lower than No. 724, just came to the level of the top windows of the burning building. He yelled to George Sykes, one of the men at the ladder, to follow him, and ran up the stairs of the next house. A minute later he and Sykes came out on the flat top. They ran to the eaves. Dugan flung himself over the front coping until his body swung free, from the knees, head downward. Sykes sat on his feet and gripped the cornice.

A Five Foot Space to Span. There was a five foot space to be spanned between the roof and the window, across which the man's figure was hanging. But Dugan made it. His big red hands slid under the arm pits of the man, his shoulders gave a queer, hoisting twist that split his best coat up the back and like a cork out of a bottle a half suffocated youth with his hair fairly stiffened in terror was yanked bodily over the window frame. For a moment he hung, with towsy dangling legs, half hidden in the smoke and then the living penumbra of which he was the weak described a clumsy air sidle, and before the boys were choking, gasping men were lying on their faces on the roof of No. 725, getting their breath back.

The man who had been saved is George Dietz, nineteen years old, a bell boy on the night shift at the Grand Union Hotel. His mother had gone to Good Friday services, leaving him asleep in the front room. When the fire engines woke him up and he ran into the hall the flames were roaring almost in his face. He was almost down and out before he got back to the window and flung himself across the ledge.

The man of Ladder Company No. 1 took long chances searching floors for persons who might have fallen in the smoke. Mrs. Nellie Nolan was certain that her fifteen-year-old son Johnny had been burned to death. Two firemen got bodily scorching searching her rooms. Just as they staggered out, blackened and blistered, the missing Johnny turned up alive and well.

While climbing an extension ladder to save a window, the man who had been saved by broken glass that he had to go to Flower Hospital, where Dietz and Burns got the last a finger, had already been taken.

The fire was put out after it had pretty well destroyed the lower floors of the building. Mrs. Dietz arrived first as her son was brought down stairs and added to the excitement by fainting.

PARROT WARNS HER OF HUSBAND'S ATTEMPT TO DIE

Bird's Persistent Calling Causes Mrs. McManus to Hurry Into the Room.

"This a good day to die—Good Friday," remarked old Patrick McManus to his feeble wife in their flat at No. 4 Macdonald street to-day. "I've always thought that when I had to die I'd like to die on Good Friday."

Mrs. McManus had been worried for weeks about her husband. His brother Owen, with whom he had been associated in the restaurant business at Liberty and West streets for more than a quarter of a century, died a year ago. The shock brought on a fit of depression.

She was to have gone to church with her husband to-day to make the pilgrimage of the Stations of the Cross, but found herself unable to leave the house. She wanted McManus to go alone, but he refused, and began to talk about death.

Warned by Parrot. Mrs. McManus went into her bedroom, knelt down before a little shrine and began to tell her beads. She left her husband in the kitchen with a parrot the couple bought twenty years ago. The old woman was praying fervently for her husband, when she heard the parrot scream:

"Mamma, mamma. Come here, mamma." This was a favorite expression used by the bird, but Mrs. McManus says she detected in it a note of alarm. Forgetting for the moment her bodily ills, she sprang to her feet and rushed to the kitchen.

Old McManus, muttering to himself about Good Friday and the end of life was climbing out through one of the windows. His wife grappled with him, but he fought her off and finally got out. She followed him and attempted to throw herself to the roof of an extension two floors below.

With superhuman strength the wife caught him by the arm and hung on. McManus, suspended in the air, sought to break her hold. The parrot and Mrs. McManus screamed, but no one heard them. The left arm of the old woman ground and rubbed against the stone window ledge until the flesh was cut to the bone.

Drops Through Roof. Suddenly her strength failed her and McManus dropped. He landed on the roof of the extension and dropped through into a restaurant kitchen and on to a little parrot, a cook, who was standing at the stove.

One of McManus' arms was broken and he sustained internal injuries. Dr. O'Connell, of the hospital, said that he was called, sent him to Bellevue and the exhausted doctor attended to the distress over the attempt of her husband at suicide was more serious than a sense of pain from the bodily injuries.

LOCKED TWO IN VAULT WHILE THEY ROBBED THE BANK

Then Shouldered Plunder, Greeted People on Street and Got Away.

COFFEYVILLE, Kan., April 17.—The Citizens' state bank, Coffeyville, twenty-five miles from here, was robbed to-day by two men, who got \$3,000.

The men entered the bank and forced Cashier C. C. Waterhouse and "Doc" Easley, a business man, to go into the vault. The bandits locked them in, secured all the currency in sight and escaped into the Osage Hills across the line to Oklahoma. Four posses are in pursuit, and as the roads are muddy, it is believed the robbers will be captured in an hour's start.

The robbery was one of the most daring ever executed in this part of Kansas, the scene of many holdups on the part of the Dalton, Starr and Brown and of others who from time to time have made their rendezvous in the mountainous country of nearby Oklahoma.

Waterhouse had scarcely opened the bank at Chattanooga this morning and placed his currency on the counter, but for the day's business when the two robbers entered. The only other person in the place was "Doc" Easley. The robbers, both of them well dressed, made their way leisurely to the cashier's window. One of them was a man well known about town, and when he commanded Waterhouse and Easley to throw up their hands, the latter two took the matter in the light of a joke.

The serious intentions of the robbers were realized a moment later, however, when they both drew revolvers and, pointing them at their victims, ordered them to get into the vault.

Without further ado Waterhouse and Easley complied. The robbers quickly slammed the door and then leisurely went about their business of looting the bank.

When they had scamped up all the money in sight they walked out the front entrance and up the main street. One of the men carried a satchel. Several persons who knew the man spoke to him in a friendly manner. Nothing in the appearance of the robbers betrayed the part they had just played. A block away they mounted horses that they had had tied at the curb and drove off. After going a few blocks from the centre of the town they directed their horses south toward the Oklahoma-Kansas State line and whipped them into a gallop. The robbery was covered soon after.
