

# ARRESTED AS PICKPOCKETS ON WHITE STAR PIER

Much Excitement Among the Hundreds Seeing Friends Off on the Adriatic.

Just before the Adriatic sailed to-day Walter Bacho, of No. 86 North Sixth street, Brooklyn, who had brought 100 storage passengers to the ship, told Lieut.-Detective Leeson, who was looking out for pickpockets, that he had seen one of two men pass a pocketbook to the other, from which he extracted a roll of bills and then dropped the purse behind a string-piece.

Leeson got Edward Mallon, the pier detective, and Patrolman John Flynn, and the three nabbed the two men as they were wriggling their way through a crowd near the gangplank. The men fought against capture and had to be roughly subdued. For a while there was

a scene resembling a riot on the wharf, where several hundred people had gathered to see friends sail.

The prisoners said they were Philip Nappi, of No. 6 Mulberry street, and Johnny Rossi, of No. 49 Grove street. The pocketbook Bacho saw them drop was found behind the string-piece. It was empty. When the men were searched \$22 was found in the pockets of one and \$30 in the pockets of the other.

They denied they had stolen any of the money. Leeson took them to Police Headquarters and turned them over to Inspector McCafferty.

## TRIED TO END HIS LIFE; SAVED BY HIS DAUGHTER.

Harris Cohen, Worried Because of Poor Business, Turns on the Gas.

When Minnie Cohen, a little girl, smelled gas at the door of the bathroom of the flat on the first floor of No. 3 East One Hundred and Eighteenth street to-day, and could get no response from her father, who was inside, she called her mother and her two brothers and they forced the lock.

Inside they found Harris Cohen, who is sixty-four years old, sitting on the floor. In his mouth was the end of a rubber tube which had been attached to a small gas stove, and the tap was turned on full.

The old man was unconscious. He was taken to Harlem Hospital, where it was said that the chances for his recovery are slim.

Cohen has fallen off considerably according to his wife, and it is supposed that worry caused him to make the attempt upon his life.

# WOMEN TRAMPLED DURING PANIC AT SOCIETY CIRCUS

Twenty Badly Injured When Seats Fall at Tent Show in Chicago.

CHICAGO, May 20.—Twenty-one persons were injured, many of them seriously, and hundreds narrowly escaped death last night at a performance of the Charity Circus, Oak Park avenue

and Thirty-third street, Berwyn, when all the seats in the tent suddenly gave way and crashed to the ground.

It was the opening night of this latest diversion of Chicago society and the tent was packed with more than 500 spectators when the accident occurred. In the panic which followed scores of women were trampled upon, and of circus performers prevented the injury of many more.

The accident was caused by a scramble of spectators to obtain sample packages of a brand of breakfast food which were being thrown from the arena by a young woman who was taking part in the circus.

## \$7,000 FOR MAN'S DEATH.

A verdict awarding Mrs. Mary McDonald \$7,000, to be paid by the Metropolitan Bridge and Construction Company, was handed down by Justice Stapleton in the Supreme Court at Flushing to-day. Mrs. McDonald is the widow of James McDonald, a workman, who was killed on the Mackinac Island Bridge a year ago. Mrs. McDonald had sued for \$30,000.
