

TROLLEY HITS TRUCK LOADED WITH LUMBER

Driver and Motorman Hurlled From Their Places and Badly Injured.

Henry Thorp, a young chap of No. 352 West Forty-eighth street, was steering two horses and a heavy truck, loaded with lumber, up Lexington avenue today. At One Hundred and Thirty-fourth street he undertook to cross over. Just as he swung his team upon the northbound car tracks there came a well-filled trolley zipping along at a clipping pace.

The motorman, Edgar Sullivan, of No. 118 East One Hundred and Second street, saw what was due to happen and he ground down his brake. But it was too late. The car hit the lumber outfit right where the tongue joined the truck. The crash was heard two blocks away.

The tongue snapped, releasing the horses, and they went at a clumsy gallop, with fragments of harness dangling about their heels. Every window in the car was broken and the dashboard bent inward until it looked disheveled. Thorp, the driver, landed twenty feet away with a broken collar bone and possible internal injuries. Sullivan was flung backward against the closed car door at the rear with such force that he rolled off the platform, half senseless.

The conductor, Peter O'Neil, of No. 75 St. Ann's avenue, the Bronx, and several of his passengers, helped Policeman Miller to care for the injured men until Dr. Harry arrived from Harlem Hospital with an ambulance.

Two citizens caught the horses before they did any damage. The wagon belonged to Ruffalo Brothers, truckmen, at No. 622 West Fifty-second street.

NAVAL GUNS READY TO BATTER MONITOR FLORIDA.

NOREFOLK, Va., May 26.—Everything is in readiness for the gunnery tests to which the monitor Florida is to be subjected in lower Chesapeake Bay tomorrow when she becomes a target for heavy firing from the turrets of her sister ship, the monitor Arkansas and torpedoes to be shot at her under water by the torpedo boat Morris. All the vessels that are to participate in the novel naval experiment are in Hampton Roads.

Commander Quimby and his men have full faith in the ability of their ship to withstand serious damage from the guns of the Arkansas and they have no doubt of the repelling by the "torpedo net" about the Florida below water line of the torpedoes that will be shot at her by the Morris. It will be a testing of the armor plates of the vessel and the ability of that class of vessel to withstand heavy firing from modern guns as well as the marksmanship of those doing the firing.
