Mrs. Evangeline Davis, nee Evangeline Washington Rogers, occasionally known to Mulberry street fame as Evangeline Jefferson Smith, was conducted into the Harlem Court at 10 o'clock this morning by Detective Washburn, of the West One Hundred and Fifty-second street station. Mrs. Davis was Washburn's prisoner; that is, she was handcuffed to him, and he was backed up by three husky uniformed men, who had come to his assistance as he was being eloped with on Lenox avenue.

She is down on the books as occasionally having sallied forth from divers places of employment with large consignments of household gear, silver, jewelry and cash. When she left, though, very suddenly, it was discovered that fifty pounds of engraved silverware, much bric-a-brac and a neat roll of greenbacks Mrs. McGeorge had secreted under the mattress had departed with her.

It was for this specific offense that Washburn was commanded to hunt up Mrs. Evangeline. He worked with diligence and patience until the trail led him to No. 133 West One Hundred and Fortieth street. There, five flights up, Washburn rang the bell and waited until the door opened on a chain and a dark countenance was observable.
