

### POLICE PUT IN A NIGHT CHASING JERSEY THIEVES

Kept Busy by Alarms and Burglaries in a Single Precinct.

The police of the Fourth Precinct in Jersey City had a busy night last night chasing burglars and answering burglar alarms.

The first call they got was at two o'clock, when Mrs. Sherry, who has apartments on the second floor of No. 218 Third street, was awakened by a noise in the yard. She ran to the front window and called for the police and Policeman Latchford responded. He went into the yard and found Frank Carey, of No. 220 Third street, next door, lying there. He had been drinking, he said, before he got home. He found his door locked and then tried to get into his house by climbing on the extension of No. 218, but he lost his balance and fell. A clothes line broke his fall and

he was only slightly injured. The officer assisted him into his house. An hour later the laundry of Wan Lung, at No. 313 Fifth street, was broken into from the rear. The laundryman awoke, and the burglar grappled with him and struck him on the head with a blunt instrument and rendered him unconscious. The man then took \$17 in cash and some clothes and departed. When Wan Lung revived about a half hour later he called for the police and Policeman Malone responded. He sent in a call to the city hospital and the injured Chinese was removed there. It is said he will recover. The apartment of Thomas Morrill, at No. 21 Summit avenue, was entered about 4 o'clock, also from the rear window. Morrill was awakened by hearing a man in the room and he grabbed the fellow, who managed to break away and make a hasty exit through the rear window, taking with him Morrill's gold watch and chain and a few dollars in money. So far the police have not obtained any trace of the burglars.
