

GUNNESS DEATH VERDICT TAKEN AS EVIDENCE

Coroner's Report That Woman Butcher Died in Fire Ruins Admitted.

LAPORTE, Ind., Nov. 12.—The defense in the case of Ray Lamphere, who is charged with the murder of Mrs. Belle Guinness and her three children, suffered its first defeat to-day when Judge Richter ruled that the report of the coroner's verdict was admissible as primary evidence.

Lamphere looked paler than usual in court to-day. Coroner Mack was the first witness on the stand to-day. He was quite uncertain with his answers at times. He testified to the finding of the bodies in the charred ruins of the Guinness home, and said that one was that of an adult female, the other three those of children.

He added that in addition to the bodies he found a number of bones in the ruins, including a piece of human vertebrae and part of a lower jawbone. The bones, which had been concealed in a jar, were then introduced in evidence. A piece of charred cloth taken from one of the corpses was also offered in evidence and was identified by the coroner.

STEEL STILL SOARS AND ALL STOCKS UP

Marie 2-5/8, St. Paul, Cleveland, C. & St. Louis, Interborough-Metropolitan, preferred and Metropolitan Street Railway 2, Southern Railway 1-3/4 and U. S. Steel 1/4. Atlantic Coast Line sagged 1/4.
