

**TRAIN KILLS SEVEN
AND INJURES THREE**

Chicago-Burlington Passenger
Strikes Handcar and
Scatters Men on It.

CHICAGO, Nov. 20.—Seven track
laborers on a hand car were run down
by a Chicago, Burlington and Quincy
Railroad passenger train between
Highland and La Grange, Ill., today
and killed. Three of the seven men
met death instantly and the other four
died almost immediately afterward.
There were ten men on the hand car.
The others escaped with slight injury.

**DR. BRISTOW'S AUTO
STOLEN FROM GARAGE.**

Woman Found Near the Place Is
Arrested, Together With a
Male Employee.

A big touring car belonging to Dr.
Alphonse P. Bristow, of No. 211 Clinton
street, Brooklyn, president of the New
York State Medical Society, was stolen
from the garage of Charles Paulis, No.
301 State street, this morning at 3
o'clock, and several hours later was
found broken down and deserted at
Fourth avenue and Pacific street.
The automobile was stolen after the
front door of the garage had been
forced. The police of the Adams street
station began an investigation, and at
the bridge found a woman who said she
was May Miles, of No. 141 Avenue A,
Manhattan.
"I'm waiting to see Charles Zende-
smith, who is employed here," she said
in reply to questions.
When Zende-smith came along he was
accused of stealing the machine. He

denied it, but the police arrested him
on suspicion and also took the woman
to the station-house charging her with
vagrandy.
Several hundred dollars will have to
be spent on the automobile before it
will be in condition to travel.
