

### DOCTOR WON HIS BRIDE BESIDE BROTHER'S COFFIN

Former Bellevue Physician Weds Daughter of Gage E. Tarbell at Garden City.

### AUTO WRECK ROMANCE.

Swift Tarbell, Injured, Was Under Dr. Rogers's Care, So Sister Met Him.

The announcement to-day of the marriage of Miss Louise Tarbell, daughter of Gage E. Tarbell, former second vice-president of the Equitable Life, to Dr. Lester Brooks Rogers, recalled to the friends of the young couple a pretty romance that had its beginning last year in a ward of Bellevue Hospital, when the bride's brother, Swift Tarbell, was a patient there, following an automobile accident.

Although the wedding took place in the Episcopal Cathedral, at Garden City, on Monday, the news has just become known, and the bride and bridegroom are being showered with congratulations. That they did not deem it necessary to take their friends into their confidence was evidenced last January, when gossip had it that they were engaged but was not sufficiently trustworthy to permit friends of the young people to offer their good wishes.

The union of Miss Tarbell and Dr. Rogers is the second happy event in the Tarbell family since the automobile accident. The other was the marriage of Swift Tarbell to Miss Virginia Marguerite Whitcomb on Nov. 19, 1907, soon after Mr. Tarbell was discharged from the hospital.

Miss Tarbell first met Dr. Rogers Aug. 4, 1907, when she hurried to Bellevue to visit her injured brother, whose condition was regarded as most critical.

Emmet L. Woodson, a member of the New York Cotton Exchange, and W. Benjamin Catlings, a wealthy mine owner, were in the machine with Tarbell when it was run down and wrecked by a third automobile car that afternoon. Catlings died from his injuries three days later.

Members of the Tarbell family were permitted to visit the hospital at all hours owing to the critical condition of Swift Tarbell. In this wise Miss Tarbell and Dr. Rogers met often.

Upon the recovery of Mr. Tarbell, Dr. Rogers was a frequent visitor at the Tarbell home. His two years' service as house surgeon at Bellevue elapsed, and he became house surgeon of the Women's Hospital.

Dr. Rogers was graduated from the New York University and then attended Bellevue Medical College, after which he became attached to the hospital staff.

**Accused by Dying Man.**  
GREENVILLE, Miss., Dec. 2.—When neighbors, attracted to the scene by pistol shots, reached the home of Mrs. George Gilmore here, yesterday, they found the woman dead and a man named Sharley, a boarder, dying. 
