

WOMAN ACCUSES HER HUSBAND OF STEALING CHILD

Mrs. Sabin Says Girl Was Taken Because of a Desire to "Get Even."

OFTEN MADE THREATS.

Mother Believes Violet Has Been Spirited Away to Oklahoma.

Mrs. Elizabeth Sabin, the mother of little Violet Sabin, who was spirited away from school yesterday afternoon by her father, is the heartiest-hearted woman in New York to-day. Violet was ten years old and had never been separated from her mother.

An Evening World reporter found Mrs. Sabin at her home, No. 29 West One Hundred and Forty-ninth street. "My husband stole Violet because he hates me and wanted to break my heart," said Mrs. Sabin. "He doesn't love her, he doesn't want her for himself. He took her in order to revenge himself on me."

Says He Made Threats. "He used to often threaten that he would take Violet and make me sorry that we had ever quarreled. I don't care about having her," he would say, "but I'll put her in a convent, where you will never see her again." He told me that was the way he meant to get even, as he put it.

"I do not know what I shall do now. My husband had plenty of money and we might have lived comfortably if he could have stopped drinking and other bad habits. A few months ago an aunt of his died and left him \$5,000. He threw up his position as bookkeeper with the Improved Sponging Company at No. 179 Wooster street then, and only used to come home about once a week. A few days ago I heard that he had spent the \$5,000, but had got \$12,000 more from another legacy."

"I shall never see Violet again, of that I am certain. My husband has some sort of a position with an oil firm in Oklahoma. I don't know in what part of the State. If he keeps Violet with him, she is as much lost to me as if she were dead."

Friends Urge Her to Act. Mrs. Sabin said that she was too heartbroken to think of instituting any legal proceedings, besides, she said she was certain that if Sabin had the child, he would never let her come back to her mother. Mrs. Sabin's friends are urging her to follow her husband if she can get any trace of him and get her little girl back. Little Violet was taken from her class in Public School No. 30 by her father yesterday afternoon. Sabin called at

"Violet's absence is all, and I must take my little girl home at once," he said.
