Dr. William T. Bull continues to exhibit a strength and vitality that are completely mystifying to those who have been attending him through his terrible ordeal.

Instead of growing weaker, the famous surgeon has become stronger. Yesterday he was again wheeled about the corridors of the Plaza, and spent more than an hour in a room overlooking the park.

Room Carefully Prepared. This room had been carefully prepared for the sick physician, and the atmosphere tempered to a degree according to his instructions.

Snow was falling lightly, painting the lawns of the park and clothing the limbs of the tall trees with a downy white.

Dr. Bull expressed delight at the scene, and insisted on remaining by the window for more than an hour, chatting all the while to his valet, his nurses and the members of his family who had joined him in the room.

Finally when he had tired of looking out of the window the sick man ordered the valet to wheel him back to his suite. In piloting the invalid's chair out of the room the valet bumped it against the door-jamb.

Dr. Bull didn't betray any annoyance. In fact, when he saw the distress on his valet's face he laughed and said: "What's the matter? Are you suffering from astigmatism?"

Returning to his room, Dr. Bull requested to hear the phonograph, and for more than an hour he listened to the canned voices of his favorite singers. This morning it was said that the surgeon was still alert and content, and that his suffering was almost nil.

IN BRIDAL GOWN GIRL TRIES TO END HER LIFE BY GAS

Believes Fiance Faithless When Disappointed in a Theatre Engagement.

Carefully dressing herself in what was to be her wedding gown, Lena Welsberger, a young milliner, lay on the bed in her furnished room at No. 517 East One Hundred and Fifty-sixth street, early to-day, and after turning on the gas, waited for death.

The girl, who had been a short time in this country, was engaged to marry Ernest Muench, a letter carrier, according to her landlady, Mrs. Thomas Ruslin, and last night left the house to accompany him to the theatre.

She returned unexpectedly at 9 o'clock, and in tears, told Mrs. Ruslin that the wedding, which was set to occur in two weeks, would not take place.

"Ernest and I have quarrelled," she sobbed, "and I don't want to live."

Mrs. Ruslin talked the girl into a more cheerful mood and when she went to bed she seemed to have recovered from her grief. Early to-day, Mrs. Ruslin smelled gas and traced it to her lodger's room. She found the girl in her fiery, stretched on the bed. Gas was pouring from two jets.

Mrs. Ruslin opened the windows and cried for help. A policeman called an ambulance from Lebanon Hospital, and the girl was revived and will recover.

"Let me die, I don't want to live," she declared, as soon as she opened her eyes.

On the dresser she had left a note for Mrs. Ruslin, inclosing a photo postcard of herself and Muench, which read as follows:

"Dear Mrs. Ruslin: Here is the picture. What you have to suffer for me! Please, Mrs. Ruslin, forgive me, for I have disgraced your house. I cannot live any longer. He is in the post-office—Ernest Muench, No. 2467 Third avenue."

35,000 WORKMEN KILLED IN YEAR BY ACCIDENTS

Government Record Also Shows 2,000,000 Were Injured—Censure Employers.

WASHINGTON, Dec. 14.—Between 30,000 and 35,000 deaths and 2,000,000 injured is the accident record in the United States during the past year among workmen, according to a bulletin on accidents issued to-day by the Bureau of Labor.

Fatal accidents among electricians and electric linemen and coal miners are declared to be excessive, while railway trainmen were killed in the proportion of 7.46 deaths per one thousand employees.

The bulletin declares that much that

could be done for the protection of the workmen is neglected, although many and far-reaching improvements have been introduced in factory practice during the last decade. It is pointed out that the possibilities for successful accident prevention have been clearly demonstrated by the experience of foreign countries.




