

ONE MAN DYING, 9 OTHERS HURT AS SCAFFOLD FALLS

Father, Buried Under Debris, Begs Rescuers to Save Son First.

ALL BADLY INJURED. Hoisted to Street in Bucket After Drop of 18 Feet in Pennsylvania Tunnel.

Ten men were injured, five of them seriously, by the fall of a scaffold in the excavations for the new Pennsylvania terminals to-day.

Buried Under Wreckage. Without warning the scaffold collapsed. It was a heavy affair, standing eighteen feet high and being thirty feet in length and four feet wide.

Hoisted in a Bucket. In order to get the men to the street, fifty feet above, it was necessary to raise them in a large bucket operated by a windlass and used ordinarily in moving supplies.
