

NINE FOUND DEAD, SIX ARE MISSING, AFTER MINE CRASH

Little Hope of Saving Victims Still Entombed in Colliery in Colorado.

TRINIDAD, Col., Feb. 10.—The bodies of four men have been taken from the Colliery Mine, wrecked by an explosion last night, and five more have been discovered. Six men are still unaccounted for. A. E. Sutton, assistant superintendent in charge of the rescue work, was overcome by gas and was carried to the surface. He will probably die.

Supt. Bailew declared today that he believed the explosion was due to the accidental discharge of blasting powder. Little hope is entertained of finding the remaining six men alive. All the dead and missing are foreigners.

HELD ON MURDER CHARGE.

Charles Londer Accused of Killing Poornate.

A coroner's jury, at the conclusion of an inquest conducted by Coroner Winterbottom, found today that Charles Londer, twenty-three years old, had killed Joseph Poornate, his room mate in No. 84 West Fifty-third street, with a hatchet and revolver.

The alleged murder was committed on Jan. 26. Londer was committed to the Tombs without bail to await the action of the Grand Jury.
