

WOMAN INJURED BY AUTO.

Steps Out of Path of Car in Front of Machine. Mrs. Ellen Brand, aged fifty years, of No. 224 Myrtle avenue, Brooklyn, was probably fatally injured this afternoon by an automobile when she was attempting to cross B'way street, Brooklyn. The automobile was owned by Herbert Krantz, president of a manufacturing company at No. 159 Seventh street. Mrs. Brand stepped backward to let a Smith street car go by and did not see the approaching machine. The chauffeur was unable to stop until the woman's body was under the running board. She was taken to the Brooklyn Hospital and it was found several of her ribs were broken and she suffered internal injuries as well.
