SUGAR TRUST FACTS ARE HIDDEN FROM THE STOCKHOLDERS

Vice-President Atkins Also Kept in Dark, Is Unable to Enlighten Congressmen.

COMPETITION IS CUT.

No Price Rivalry With Pacific Companies Because of Freight Rate Differences.

WASHINGTON, June 13.—Effort to discover whether non-competitive zones had been established by the American Sugar Refining Company in an effort to control prices marked the resumption of the "Sugar Trust" inquiry today.

Mr. Atkins declared, however, that the American Sugar Refining Company owned practically a majority of stock in the sugar refineries in California and that it did not attempt to compete with them.
