

TAXI WRECKED IN HEAD-ON CRASH WITH TROLLEY

Seriously Hurt and Car
Passengers Showered With
Broken Glass.

Charles Hamburg, thirty years old, of No. 40 East Seventy-ninth street, part owner of a taxicab and driving it, is in a grave condition at the Presbyterian Hospital and only debris is left of his cab. At 1:30 o'clock this morning he drove the taxi north on the south-bound trolley track at Madison avenue and Sixty-eighth street. A southbound car wrecked the taxi and nearly killed Hamburg.

John O'Brien, a watchman of No. 351 East Forty-third street, saw the accident. He says that Hamburg crossed to the wrong side of the street to avoid a stalled automobile a block below.

Both the car and taxi were going at a fair rate of speed when the head-on crash came. The night was foggy and the tracks were wet. The car was in charge of Motorman John J. O'Brien of No. 30 West One Hundred and Forty-ninth street, and Conductor Julius Pollock of No. 61 East One Hundred and Seventeenth street.

The impact tore the top from the cab and threw it twenty-five feet. Hamburg, clinging to his steering wheel, was hurled as far in another direction. The front vestibule of the car was smashed in, and the motorman was showered with glass. Several passengers in the car were slightly cut by glass from broken windows.

O'Brien, who was one of the first

on the scene, summoned a policeman and called Dr. Devine from the Presbyterian Hospital, but Jarvis O'Connor, driver of another taxicab, carried Hamburg to the hospital before the ambulance arrived.

Hamburg has a broken right leg, internal injuries and perhaps a fractured skull.

RIDGWAYS HAVE NARROW ESCAPE IN AUTO WRECK.

Publisher and Wife Thrown From

Erman J. Ridgway, publisher of Everybody's Magazine, and Mrs. Ridgway, had a narrow escape from serious injury in Montclair last night when their automobile collided with the automobile of Leonard H. Hole, a banker of this city. Mr. Hole's chauffeur was the only occupant of his car.

The collision occurred on a precipitous ascent of Union street. Mr. Ridgway's car was descending the hill and the Hole car was climbing. The impact wrecked the banker's big car and threw Mr. and Mrs. Ridgway out. They rolled in a gully filled with leaves and escaped without a scratch.

Only yesterday Mrs. Hole met with an unusual accident in her home. While walking across her drawing-room a rug on which she stepped slipped and she fell heavily against a marble-topped table, breaking her arm in three places.
