

### WIFE OF 8 YEARS LOST IN 2 MINUTES TO VINCENT BRYAN

Song Writer Sued for Divorce  
Result of Gay Time  
on Broadway.

Vincent Bryan, whose lyrics, rolicking and sentimental, have been caroled by singers from Broadway to the Big Tree Corners for years, lost a wife in exactly two minutes in Justice Br-linger's part of the Supreme Court to-day. The newest divorcee is Mrs. Rae Bry-lyn Bryan, wife of Edgar Bryan, the playwright, and an actress. Bryan contested the action for a divorce up to a week ago.

The giddy whirl of the Country Club fraternity, where he imbibed the atmosphere of "Please Don't Take Me Home," the nocturnal gavottes of glided later, a famous singer in Europe, her friends say, had been inclined to punish Vincent for his careless ways. Recently Mrs. Bryan began to hear tales of her husband's escapades along the White Way. Reluctantly she put detectives on his trail. The chase was a short and decisive one, ending in Bryan being bagged "with the goods." The "goods" was a prominent Broadway songstress of about 125 pounds, with blonde hair and deep eyes and two sets of toes which have twinkled hundreds of times before Broadway audiences. ### TO ASK CHANGE IN LAW AS TO TRUST DISSOLUTIONS.

Tobacco Company Case, in Which  
Supreme Court Denies Review,  
Stirs Cummins to Action.

WASHINGTON, Dec. 12.—The action of the Circuit Court for the Southern District of New York, approving plans for the dissolution of the Tobacco Trust, will not only become the topic of discussion in Congress but form the basis of attempted legislation. Senator Cummins gave notice late yesterday that he will speak on the subject Wednesday. A bill was also introduced by Senator Cummins permitting appeals to the Supreme Court in certain cases. It is intended to legalize appeals from other than the Government and the parties

directly interested when such litigation arises. Under its provisions the independent could object to the agreed dissolution and bring the matter up to the Supreme Court for review and determination.

The Supreme Court yesterday apparently settled the controversy relating to the plan of the Tobacco Trust dissolution. It denied the motion for permission to file a petition for review made on behalf of the Leaf Tobacco Board of Trade of New York. The result is to allow the dissolution to proceed.
