Oddities In the News Of To-Day

First Person to Be Fined for Buying a Single Drink.
G. H. Potter, twenty, is the first person on record to be fined for buying a drink. He was fined \$5 at Putnam, Conn., for buying a glass of beer.
That State has a new law prohibiting a minor from purchasing liquor. Potter's case was the first of its kind in the country.

Uncle Sam Spends a Million in His Fire Hunt.
It developed in a hearing at Washington that the Government is engaged in the biggest fire hunt on record, and has already spent \$1,000,000 in California.
It is exterminating ground squirrels, which carry the fleas which carry bubonic plague. Ten thousand infected squirrels have been found.

His "Ghosts" Have Wings and Left Him Quite a Treasure.
F. L. Blinnham and family of Ravine road, Plainfield, N. J., have notified their neighbors to call off the dogs and put up their weapons, because the ghost has been laid.
The spook with its weird notes had worried Blinnham for some time, and Chief of Police Kiely was called. He found under an attic floor a big swarm of bees and twenty-five pounds of honey.

Folks Betting Real Money on the Presidential Election.
Wall Street is already doing a little wild betting on the next Presidential election, but all the money is wagered on Roosevelt.
There are small bets of 1 to 5 that Roosevelt will be nominated and elected. No other bets have been recorded thus far.

Jersey Solomon Gives Young Prisoner a Novel Alternative.
When John Perry, twenty-two, of Nutley, was arraigned before Recorder-Paer he was told that he could take his choice of paying a fine with the \$10 found on him or sending it to his mother and taking the blame.
He told the Court to send the money to his mother and then signed the pledge.

Connecticut's Only Cave Dweller Is Sent to a Cell.
John Brennan, twenty-one years old, for more than a year lived in a cave at Riverside, near Stamford, and terrorized the inhabitants by his wild ways.
Finally he was tracked to his retreat, captured and sentenced to four months in jail.

Playmates Oddly Die at Same Minute From Similar Accidents.
Gertrude Zimmerman and Mable Simon, playmates living near each other in Elizabeth, N. J., and each five years old, died at the same minute in the same hospital from burns received by playing with matches in their respective homes.

Girl Life Saver Gets Medal From Canadian Society.
Miss Sarah Lane, at elaborate exercises in the High School at Schenectady, was presented with a medal on behalf of the Canadian Royal Humane Society.
The honor was in recognition of her heroism Aug. 21, last, when she saved Miss Eliza Knapp from drowning in New Brunswick.
