

**SEARCH FOR WILL OF E. R. HAWLEY IS WITHOUT RESULT**

Now Believed That Financier Left None, and Legal Heirs Will Administer Estate.

No trace of any will left by Edwin R. Hawley, the railroad financier, has been found as yet and it is now believed he left none. Although no contact is expected among the heirs to his estate, there is some conjecture as to just what effect the lack of a will may have upon the many interests with which he was connected.

That no serious financial entanglements will result from the absence of the will was the sentiment expressed this afternoon by Newman Erb, one of the dead financier's most intimate business associates. Mr. Erb said that even though a will is never found, all the heirs are in harmony. The large interests Mr. Hawley controlled are so thoroughly safeguarded, said Mr. Erb, that it is impossible for serious trouble to arise.

"If no will is found," said Mr. Erb this afternoon in his office at No. 42 Broadway, "no part of the estate can be sold by the heirs until a year has passed. That is the law."

**ASSOCIATES WILL CARRY OUT HIS PLANS.**

"Although Mr. Hawley was a leader, like all big financial men he did not stand alone. He worked always with associates who were in accord with his plans."

"Of course there are some details that have been temporarily halted owing to Mr. Hawley's death. There were some things that should have been done today which were indefinitely postponed. All of Mr. Hawley's plans will be carefully carried out to their conclusion just as he planned. The railroads in which Mr. Hawley was most heavily interested were the Chesapeake and Ohio, the Minneapolis and St. Louis and the Missouri, Kansas and Texas. He held a controlling interest in them. I don't think the Chicago and Alton was under his control. Gen. Hubbard, I think, is the holder of the majority of stock."

At the offices of Hawley & Davis at No. 25 Broad street, nobody would discuss anything. Neither Mr. Davis nor any of Mr. Hawley's partners would say a word.

No new safe deposit boxes belonging to Mr. Hawley have been opened, said representatives of the State Comptroller. Mr. Taylor, of the law firm of Byrne and Cutcheon, who were Mr. Hawley's personal attorneys, said no will has been discovered by the firm.

Frank H. Davis, the partner of Mr. Hawley, William P. Hawley, Walter C. Candell and Charles Seymour, nephews of the financier, held a conference last night at the Hawley home in Charleston, N. Y. Frank Tompkins, another member of the firm of Hawley & Davis, also attended the conference.

**LAWYERS KNOW NOTHING OF WILL; SEARCH FRUITLESS.**

Mr. Taylor, of the law firm of Byrne & Cutcheon of No. 21 Broad street, Mr. Hawley's attorney, when seen by an Evening World reporter to-day, said his firm knew nothing of any will that Mr. Hawley might have made.

"We acted in many matters for Mr. Hawley," said Mr. Taylor, "but we drew no will for him. He never consulted us about the matter. We handled a number of cases for him, but few of them were personal affairs. I am confident our firm does not know of the existence of any will."

Thomas E. Smith, representing the State Comptroller, was present when Mr. Hawley's safe deposit box in the Standard Safe Deposit Company was opened. Mr. Davis was present representing the Hawley interests. No will was found.

From the reference of all concerned it is generally believed in Wall Street now that there is no will in existence.
