

FOUR YEARS TENTH TERM FOR BURGLAR

Another Housebreaker Sent to Penitentiary for Year on Guilty Plea.

Seven prisoners under indictment for various crimes were disposed of yesterday by the Judges of the Courts of General Sessions. They are:

BY JUDGE O'BULLIVAN. Edward Goldsmith, twenty-two years old, indicted for arson, first degree. Sent five to tenement at No. 233 Eighth avenue, night of Oct. 31, 1917. Indicted in case. Sent to State Asylum for Insane Criminals at Matteawan.

Giuseppe Scilio, thirty-three years old; Vincenzo Diel, twenty-five years old, and Giuseppe Arardi, twenty-five years old, indicted for extortion. Black-bananas. Tried and convicted. No prior conviction. Sent to State Asylum for Insane Criminals under threat of death. State Prison not less than five years or more than seven years and six months.

BY JUDGE CRAIN. Thomas Murray, fifty-two years old, indicted for burglary, third degree. Pleaded guilty. Caught robbing shoe store at No. 51 First avenue, Feb. 27. Pleaded guilty. Sent to State Asylum for Insane Criminals. Admitted to various prisons. State Prison for four years and six months. Maximum penalty five years.
