MUEHLFELDT HELD ON CHARGE OF MURDER.

Francis Muehlfeldt, aged thirty-five, was arraigned to-day in Morrisania Police Court on a charge of killing adoonkeeper Patrick Burns, preferred by Detectives Casassa and McKenna, who arrested him yesterday in Winland N.
