

**POPE PIUS X. IS 77;
BLESSES 27 AMERICAN
PRIESTS AS 'APOSTLES'**

**Pontiff Receives Thousands of
Callers as He Celebrates
His Birthday.**

SOME, June 2.—His Holiness Pope Pius X. celebrated his seventy-seventh birthday yesterday and the day will be memorable to twenty-seven American students, just ordained priests, whom he received with Bishop Kennedy, rector of the American College. His Holiness looked well and was in high spirits. He referred to the young men as "twenty-seven apostles."

"St. Philip," said he, "would convert the world with only six priests. Who knows how much good for the Catholic Church you will do?"

He blessed the young priests repeatedly and requested them to tell the Americans the Pope loved them. And he asked all to pray for him.

The Pontiff received birthday congratulations from all over the world and friends called in great numbers. Vatican troops participated in an imposing demonstration. His Holiness gave audience to the morning to 1,000 children, first communicants, and 700 parishioners of Trastevere. The evening he spent with his sisters.

BELMONT'S DOG GONE.


