

## Campaign Sidelights

Registration is again an important issue of the campaign. Only two days remain for voters in which to prepare for the exercise of their suffrages. The polls open at 7 o'clock tomorrow morning and remain open until 10 o'clock at night. The same hours prevail on Saturday. All parties are urging upon voters the necessity of registering. The registration in the city is away behind this year. It is hoped the remaining two days will make up for the loss of last week. In registering for election day it is not necessary for voters to enroll as members of any party. Some attempts were made to compel the voters to enroll on last Friday and Saturday. If an inspector hands you an enrollment blank and you do not want to enroll, hand it back to him. The Progressive party managers urge their supporters not to enroll. Every voter should register, however.

Gov. Wilson is in Wilmington, Del., today. This week will close his speaking campaign with the possible exception of the meeting of October 21 in Madison Square Garden. It is thought that this meeting which was scheduled to be his windup of the campaign will be held in deference to the condition of Roosevelt the Governor voluntarily abandoned the stump, but there is every indication from the reports at Chicago that the Colonel, with his vigorous constitution and splendid physical condition will be again on deck before that time. Gov. Wilson is booked for a meeting in Brooklyn on Saturday night and another at Carnegie Hall under the auspices of the German-Americans. Everything had been prepared for these demonstrations and in the circumstances it would be hardly fair to those behind them to cancel the date.

The Progressive party still hopes to substitute Gov. Hiram Johnson for Col. Roosevelt in the latter's speech making itinerary. The law of California allows only sixty days leave of absence to its Governor and permission to leave the State is granted by the Legislature. Gov. Johnson's time will expire on the 26th. Chairman G. W. Perkins talked with him over the long-distance telephone yesterday and some time today he is expected to give his answer. Meantime he is endeavoring to ascertain if there is any way in which an extension of time can be had.

The Suiser special will leave for up-State tomorrow morning. The candidate will start from the New York Central depot at 9 o'clock with his baggage checked for Troy. Congressman Suiser is going to make some speeches on that train. He opens up at Tarrytown and will close at Troy tomorrow night. During the day he will make twenty speeches, seventeen of them from the rear of the train, the rest in halls. On the following day he will make eighteen talks. The gubernatorial nominee is in the best of condition and fit for the fight of his life.

Senator Gore, the blind Senator of Oklahoma, is going to remain in New York for the rest of the campaign. The Senator is Chairman of the Organization Committee of the Democratic National Committee. His activities, though, for the rest of the campaign will be utilized on the stump throughout the State. The brilliant blind orator of Oklahoma will be a great drawing card.

State Chairman Herzhikins of the Bull Moose Committee has declared that there will be no more recommitments in the campaign, at any rate as far as the Progressive State speakers are concerned. When he adds that they are going after Candidate Suiser on his record, to which Mr. Suiser replied: "Come on." This is like the two Irishmen who had a fight. The verbal articles of agreement were that there was

to be no kicking when a man was down. One went down and the other began kicking. The kicker remonstrated. "I thought you said there was no kicking," he declared indignantly. "Well, you can kick a little," replied the victor, and he kept on kicking.

Chairman George W. Perkins of the Bull Moose Executive Committee leaves for Washington this evening. He goes on the witness stand to-morrow before the Senate Committee on Campaign Contributions. Mr. Perkins has all the appearance of a very willing witness. He is dying to get a poke at Chairman Hillis of the Republican National Committee. If he does there will be another deluge of correspondence to animate the dullness of the campaign.

Chairman McCombs of the Democratic National Committee is on the job again. He got down to real business yesterday when he met the wise man from the West who came from Chicago to confer with the wise men of the East in the Campaign Committee. Mr. McCombs said this morning he was feeling fine and ready for the fray. Acting Chairman Meadood, who has been doing yeoman's work in Mr. McCombs's absence, welcomed his colleague most heartily and the two were immersed in work this morning. Everybody at headquarters wore a pleasant smile and said it was good to see the Chairman "home" again.

George B. Cortelyou was a visitor at the Bull Moose headquarters yesterday afternoon. This is the first appearance of Mr. Cortelyou within the lines during the campaign. His visit was to get at first hand the latest news from Col. Roosevelt.

It was very quiet at headquarters of the Republican National Committee today, and it seemed a shame to wake anybody up. But there is to be an awakening within the next few days. Chairman Hillis is going to make public the list of the contributors to the campaign fund. Ah!


