

COURT SAVES BOY ACCUSED BY FATHER OF USING "JIMMY"

Sixteen-Year-Old Dan Corcoran Gets "Chance" After His Fifth Arrest.

The door of opportunity opened today for Dan Corcoran, a boy who says he has "never had a chance," in the last place in the world one would expect, namely, a Magistrate's court. Corcoran, a tall, thin lad of sixteen with pinched features and a hunted look in his intelligent eyes, told Magistrate O'Connor in the West Side Court today that his father had hounded the spirit out of him until he felt like "struck things up."

John T. Corcoran, portly and prosperous, flushed as his son told of arrest after arrest on complaint of his father, who is a civil engineer and lives with his third wife at No. 150 Manhattan avenue. The boy has been living in a furnished room at No. 827 Columbus avenue and supporting himself by odd jobs.

The last arrest was on Saturday, when the elder Corcoran found his son in the hallway outside his apartment. According to his story he found marks of a Jimmy on the door and had the boy arrested on a charge of burglary. The boy said he had come there to see if he could get something to eat.

Harvard Professor Takes His Rest in "Twilight State" and Is Always Conscious.

BOSTON, Feb. 17.—A Harvard professor who has not slept for twenty years but has taken his rest in the "twilight state" is the subject of investigations by the psychological laboratory of the university and the State Psychopathic Hospital. The "twilight state," in which the subject retains consciousness of all that goes on about him, is declared to be a scientific relaxation more satisfactory than sleep, and restoring the bodily vigor in about half the time required by sleep.

To assist in experiments at the State Psychopathic Hospital on the "twilight state," a special easy chair has been constructed. It is described as a device to aid subjects to relax "as completely as a gallon of molasses on a slab of cold marble."
