

**MEN AND WOMEN
BEAT WIFE-STABBER
SENSELESS IN STREET**

Crowd Attacks Dull on Seeing Him Wield Stiletto Made of Wood.

After stabbing his wife three times

with a stiletto which he had fashioned from a stick of hardwood, Lawrence Dull, a cooper, of No. 81 North Seventh street, was mobbed and beaten into insensibility by a crowd in Williamsburg today.

Mrs. Dull left her husband three months ago, after having been brutally treated for years. He found her to-day and demanded that she return and live with him. When she refused he attacked her, stabbing her in the throat, breast and hand. The attack was at North Sixth and Berry streets. Men and women fell on the husband and beat him and kicked him until he lay senseless.

Two policemen finally reached Dull and took him to the Bedford avenue station. The wounded wife was taken to the Williamsburg Hospital. She is in a serious condition.

**AVIATOR IN SEA PERIL
ON FLIGHT TO LONDON.**

Savelack, With Compass Useless, Loses Bearings and Narrowly Escapes Death Plunge.

ESSEN, Germany, Feb. 24.—Josef Savelack, the well-known German aviator, had a narrow escape from death yesterday while attempting a venture-some flight in his monoplane from this city to London, England. He ascended during a dense low lying fog. After passing through this and reaching a higher altitude his compass got out of order. As he could not see the earth he attempted to steer by the sun, but after an hour's flight lost his bearings and determined to land.

He slid down through the banks of fog and then noticed that he was over the North Sea. A storm was blowing and the spray from the waves was drenching his aeroplane before he could succeed in starting the motor again and rising away from danger. He turned his machine around and soon afterward the fog cleared and he made his way to Davenport, Holland, where he landed after a voyage which had lasted one hour and forty-five minutes.

Steamer American Floated.

SEA ISLE CITY, N. J., Feb. 24.—The Dutch tank steamer American, Antwerp Feb. 7 for Philadelphia, which went ashore off here during a fog on Saturday, was floated at high tide today with the assistance of two wrecking tugs. The tanker will proceed to Philadelphia.

SHOOTING IN DANCE HALL.

Deputy Sheriff Is Held for Wounding Negro.

Edward Edwards, a negro, twenty-one years old, of No. 11 Hubross avenue, Jamaica, Queens, is in St. Joseph's Hospital, Far Rockaway, with a pistol bullet in his left breast and a lacerated scalp wound, caused by another bullet. His condition is considered serious.

Fred Kabell, a Nassau County deputy sheriff, is under arrest, charged with the shooting, which occurred early this morning in the dance hall of John Joseph, at No. 11 Lake Grove place, Far Rockaway. Kabell fled, but was arrested at 4:15 o'clock this morning by Detective Newman at Inwood and taken to Far Rockaway.
