

**DETECTIVES SEARCH THROUGH NEW YORK FOR MISSING CASHIER**

**Pretty Woman of Netcong Is Gone Too—\$8,000 Taken From Till.**

Detectives employed by the Citizens' National Bank of Netcong, N. J., are in New York to-day looking for J. Frank Best, late cashier of the unlucky institution and possessor, according to the charge, of \$8,000 which should be in the till at present. A woman with whom Best was frequently seen in this city is being sought. She was well known in Netcong and disappeared about the time Best severed his connections with the institution. The absconding cashier was secretary of the Musconetcong Building and Loan Association and the members of that body are anxious to meet him. Examination of the books shows that Best had been juggling the accounts of the association, transferring the money taken from the bank's account and back again to the Loan Association when either side of the column needed atten-

tion. For a year the juggling continued until there was over \$4,000 missing. Best was at his place Saturday morning, after an evening spent in several New York cafes. A telephone message came saying that the bank examiner would be at the Citizens' bank that afternoon. At luncheon Best joked about the coming examination and said he was going to lunch. Very coolly he extracted a package from the till and placed it in his pocket. None of the clerks knew what it was, but when Best did not return after several hours they were alarmed.

Then the examiner arrived and a few minutes' work brought out the story. The package contained \$4,000 in bills. Best, the absconding cashier, was bonded for \$15,000. **Flagg Asks \$100,000; Gets 0.** Jared Flagg Jr. lost his suit yesterday against Edward R. Carroll, Chief Clerk of General Sessions, and William Hannah, his deputy, from whom Flagg demanded \$100,000. Through an error in certifying to his court record as asserted, they had charged him with a felony. The case was tried before Justice Ames and a jury in the Supreme Court.
