
GIRLS LEAP FROM WINDOWS IN RAID ON TAVERN DANCE.

TREVINO PUT TO DEATH FOR ATTEMPT TO BUY BLANCO TO HUERTA

Offered Him \$300,000 and a Generalship to Take Army Over to Federals.

BROWNVILLE, Tex., June 8.—Three hundred thousand pesos and a generalship in the Federal army was the price offered Gen. Lucio Blanco, commander of the victorious "Constitutionalist" forces in Matamoros, if he and his army would join and swear allegiance to the Huerta government, according to Francisco Jose Mujica, chief of staff of Gen. Blanco.

Blanco's staff was offered the same rank in the Federal army as now held by them in the Constitutionalist army. Mujica says: The offer was made by Gen. Trevino of Monterrey, Gen. Fernando Gonzalez, chief of Huerta's army in Nuevo Leon, and Gen. Juan de Dios Aramendi, chief of arms at Victoria, according to Mujica.
