J., June 10.—Fourteen multi-millionaires, representing some of the largest railroad and one building interests in the United States, were aboard the pleasure steamer launch Nanshan, owned and captained by Col. Hubbard of Kentucky, brother of the owner of the boat; Henry Morrison, the car manufacturer of Pittsburgh. Together they represented railroad manufacturing interests running into the hundreds of million dollars.
