

### CRASHING OF IMPERATOR MAY BREAK STRIKE OF THE LONGSHOREMEN

Duoity Between Two Unions  
Cause of Present Tie-Up  
of Big Liners.

The Italian Gov't do as much work for the money they get as the Americans, Irish, Norwegians, English and other more robust workmen. To add to the bad feeling between the two unions Italian labor has done most of the non-union work that has been done in the loading and unloading of ships.

The Kaiserin Augusta Victoria, which arrived from Hamburg Monday, has not had her cargo removed, but other ships have been handled. The President Grant, sailing to-day, was loaded by non-union labor, but is not carrying a full cargo. If the strike continues the Kaiserin Augusta Victoria will be unloaded in South Brooklyn.

The arrival of the big Emperor promises to bring about a crisis in the strike. Although the immense ship does not carry much cargo, she needs 2,000 tons of coal for one of her voyages.

As she is to sail Saturday there are but two and a half days available for getting out her cargo and putting in her coal. Longshoremen are needed in great numbers in coaling such a ship. If the Hamburg-American line can co-act the Emperor without the aid of the striking longshoremen it is expected that the strike will come to an end.

The North-German Lloyd and Holland-America line, docking at Hoboken, have not been affected by the strike. It is not likely that the trouble will spread to the liners of these companies. The strikers have been unofficially notified that if they raise any doubts they will find the police force of Hoboken against them.
