

RAY EGG IMPORTERS SWINDLED RAILROAD ON FRAUDULENT CLAIMS

New York Central Attorney Asks Court for Sight of Accused Firm's Books.

The New York Central Railroad through William Mann, one of its attorneys, asked permission of Supreme Justice Donnelly to-day, to inspect the books of R. B. Shimer & Co., commission merchants of Washington street, and ascertain how much money the railroad corporation was swindled out of through graft on the part of its importers.

Shimer & Co. handle a large egg business over the New York Central lines and according to United States Attorney C. Woodson Marshall, the railroad was swindled out of \$38,000, which was paid out on alleged fraudulent claims for broken eggs. The claims were passed by the railroad's inspectors.

Attorney Mann told Justice Donnelly that both Henry C. Shimer and Adolph Parsons, directors of the firm, had pleaded guilty in the United States court to a charge of having bribed railroad inspectors regularly for a number of years to expedite the removal of the firm's produce consignments and get them into the city of New York ahead of competitors. Both directors paid their pro rata of \$1,000 fine.

When Mr. Mann demanded that he be given permission to examine the books for six years back, Attorney Louis Marshall declared that it would be a fishing mission. He also intimated that the books had disappeared or had been destroyed, declaring that the firm had no books further back than Nov. 1, 1912. Justice Donnelly told the lawyers that he would decide whether or not the books could be gone over some time next week and he gave both sides an opportunity to file closing briefs.
