

FOUR BCYS LOOTING GROCERY ARE ARRESTED

Juveniles Had Taken About \$200 Worth of Stuff When Detectives Got Them.

Detectives Scheuing and Sullivan of the Morrisania station saw three boys hold the fourth over the tramway of Joseph Cost's grocery at No. 231 East One Hundred and Fifty-first street early this morning and then open the vacant store at No. 233 with a pass key. The boy inside plucked about \$200 worth of groceries which his companions stacked up in the vacant store. All were arrested.

The boys said they were Peter Margasi of No. 62 Morris avenue, Patrick Guarino of No. 230 First avenue, Joseph Boule of No. 52 Morris avenue and John Sylvester of No. 233 East One Hundred and Fifty-first street. Boule said he was sixteen and each of the others seventeen.

Magistrate Bressan in the Morrisania Court held the boys in \$200 bail for examination to-morrow.
