

RACE FROM A DANCE WITH GIRL WHO TOOK BICHLORIDE TABLETS

Escort's Effort May Save Life of Girl Who Got Wrong Box in Dark.

A race with a young woman who had taken bicloride of mercury tablets at Terrace Garden ended in Bellevue Hospital shortly after last midnight.

She was Miss Marie Goss, eighteen, of No. 206 Atlantic avenue, Brooklyn, who attended the dance given by Kiew Lodge, I. O. B. A. While sitting in a box with John M. Black of No. 168 St. Mark's place, Brooklyn, she became suddenly ill, and told him she thought she would hurry home.

Black offered to get her some medicine, but she said she had just swallowed two bicloride tablets which she took from a medicine chest before leaving home.

The box lay in her lap and Black picked it up. To his astonishment he saw a label "poison" and "bicloride of mercury."

"I took the wrong box in the dark," exclaimed the girl when Black told her. He did not give her time to faint. He summoned a friend and the two dragged the girl out of the hall without even letting her get her wrap to cover her blue velvet ball gown. They half carried her up the stairs of the Third avenue elevated at Fifty-ninth street.

The trio alighted at Twenty-third street and headed for Bellevue on the run. At First avenue they fled past Patrolman Kelly without explanation. He ran after them, but was far in the rear when they reached the admitting ward.

After further explanations Drs. Klingner and Procter took Miss Goss in hand and administered antidotes. It was said that she probably will recover.
