

**SCHIFF AND PARTNERS
IN COURT TO TESTIFY
ABOUT DREXEL DEAL**

Broker Who Didn't Sell Baldwin Works Is Suing Seller for His Fee.

The \$200,000 suit of George H. Robinson, a New Rochelle broker, against A. B. Johnson of Dover, Del., growing out of the sale of the Baldwin Locomotive Works to Drexel & Co. of Philadelphia for \$2,000,000 cash and \$10,000,000 common stock in the reorganized company was begun this morning before Judge Hand in the United States District Court.

Mortimer L. Schiff, Jacob H. Schiff, Paul Warburg and a number of other leading Wall street men were in the court as witnesses for the plaintiff.

Robinson contends that he interested Kuhn, Loeb & Co. in the purchase, and on April 11 he met Jacob H. Schiff and Mortimer L. Schiff and Paul Warburg and arranged for the sale of the works for \$2,000,000 in cash and \$10,000,000 in common stock of the reorganized company.

Johnson was secretly negotiating with the Drexel Company, and at last sold the works to them. This deal brought only \$2,000,000 to the stockholders, while the one he had on would have netted them \$2,000,000, he says.

On cross-examination by John G. Millburn, attorney for Johnson, Robinson admitted that he had been told to sell for not less than \$2,000,000. He told Johnson, he testified, that Kuhn, Loeb & Co. had offered \$10,000,000 in cash, but that he believed the bankers would pay the higher price. His authority to sell ended by agreement after Feb. 17, 1914, but on that date, he said, he had another meeting with Johnson, and then reopened negotiations with Kuhn, Loeb & Co.
