

# DANCER-DRUMMER DEMANDS \$25,000 FOR BROKEN HEART

Florence Greene Declares She Tripped Lightly Into Van Antwerpen's Affections.

SHE HAS LOVE LETTERS.

Says Diamond Dealer Followed Her to Boston and Always Had Best Seat.

Miss Florence Greene, who declares she danced her way into the affections of George Van Antwerpen, a wealthy diamond dealer of No. 535 Pearl street, fled a suit in the Supreme Court yesterday for \$25,000 for alleged breach of promise of marriage.

Miss Greene alleges she not only gave up a promising stage career for Van Antwerpen, but when he went to Europe last summer and she suspected his love had grown cold, she followed, only to be placed aboard a ship a few days after she arrived there and sent back home.

"He promised in September, 1909, that he would marry me," said Miss Greene, "and after I had waited four years he told me he was through with me, as he was engaged to another woman."

Miss Greene was a drummer girl in "Little Nemo" when she met Van Antwerpen. She says he showered her with attentions and gave her many handsome presents.

"When the company left New York," she added, "Mr. Van Antwerpen went to Boston with us. In all he saw the show twenty-seven times, and always from a box or the front row."

To substantiate her charges, Miss Greene has many love letters which she says Van Antwerpen wrote her. One of the letters, made public by the young woman's lawyer, George Robinson of No. 99 Nassau street, fellows in part:

"To the Girl I Love—I often ask myself why I love you, but I cannot find any explanation. I am crazy about you and I cannot live happy when you are not near me. If you should deceive me in the confidence I have in you I will suffer much, very much."

Here is another: "My Dearest Little One—How good of you, darling, to remember me so well on my birthday, and more than that, send me a beauty of a present. You have really spoiled me. You have done more for me than I deserve, and it was most unexpected to be treated so well by the only little girl I love or even care for. I am far from you, dear, but not so far in mind. On the contrary, I am near you, thinking of you and of the happy days only. But once more we are the same little sweethearts, and in not such a very long while will I make a decision for my future life."

Still another said: "My Darling—I am really suffering since you wrote to me that you were getting this. Oh, please believe me again, Flory. Cheer up, so that when

I see you I don't need to worry about your health. I cannot say anything yet, but in a short while from now—that is, in maybe two or three weeks—I will know better what I will do later on. I am trying to return to America, and more especially to you. From your Georgie, who would that he might kiss you a thousand and one times and is longing for you."

After Miss Greene said she had written to Van Antwerpen, scolding him for his apparent indifference on one occasion, she declared she received the following letter: "My Darling Flory—The letters you write to me simply tear my heart to pieces. You know and feel how much
