

BLIND WOMAN ABLAZE PRAYING AT CASKET OF CHILD BURNED

Rescued After Her Clothing
Had Caught Fire From
Flaming Curtains.

While she was praying beside the casket of her three-year-old grand-daughter, who was burned to death Monday, Mrs. Louisa Aurelio's clothing caught fire at 8 A. M. to-day at No. 283 West Twenty-fifth street and she came near losing her own life. Frank De Rosa, her son-in-law, was severely burned in rescuing the aged woman, who is blind.

De Rosa lives on the second floor with his wife, his children and his mother-in-law. On Monday afternoon Mrs. De Rosa brought Rose, three years old, and her year-old baby in from an airing. She went through the house lighting the gas and carefully threw a lighted match into a cuspidor. The next minute she had gone downstairs to bring up the baby's carriage.

Little Rose saw the burning match and fished it out of the cuspidor. The blind grandmother was in the next room and could not locate Rose when she heard her scream. By the time she reached the child she was so badly burned she died, and the funeral was set for this afternoon.

Early to-day the grandmother went into the front parlor to pay her last devotions. The others were in the kitchen. A breeze blew a curtain into the flame of a candle and the furnishings of the room were blazing. The grandmother's clothing was ignited. Hearing her screams, De Rosa rushed into the room and smothered his mother-in-law's burning garments.

After carrying her into the hall he ran back and snatching the curtains and other furnishings from chairs and walls threw them out the window into Eighth avenue. Then he carried the casket, only slightly scorched, into the hall. Firemen made short work of what was left of the blaze. De Rosa went to New York Hospital, suffering from burns on the face, hands and head. Mrs. Aurelio's burns were so slight she did not have to go to the hospital.

Mother and Two Children Perish. ST. LOUIS, Mo., May 20.—Trapped by a fire while asleep, Mrs. Rebecca Coltz, twenty-four, her son, Morris, three, and her daughter, Lottie, four, perished early to-day. Firemen made desperate efforts to enter the building and save the woman and children, but the stairways were a mass of flames. A broken hand handicapped their work.

ARRESTED, HE SAYS: "I'VE TAKEN POISON!"

Take Prisoner From Hotel to Bellevue and Give Antidote for Mercury.

Albert Rosenthal, aged fifty-six, of No. 507 West One Hundred and Eighty-third street, was arrested in the Hotel Netherlands last night by Detective Carmody charged with passing a worthless check. On the way to the station-house Rosenthal told the detective that he had swallowed two bichloride of mercury tablets. Carmody called an ambulance and sent his prisoner to Bellevue, where he was given anti-dotes and held as a prisoner. Rosenthal, according to James E. Lowe, cashier of the Netherlands, came to the hotel on April 15 last, remaining until April 23, and on leaving paid his bill with a check on the Logan Trust Company of Philadelphia, signed "G. Rosenthal," which afterward proved to be worthless. Last night Rosenthal unexpectedly appeared outside the hotel, and the cashier, after a scuffle, took him in-

the and imprisoned for the police. According to the descriptive, Rosenthal made a full confession.
