Marriage License Bureau Is Being Transferred to Municipal Building.

Stilled forever are the hurrahs in the dimly basement where poet and peasant, millionaire and stenographer, nobles and common stock came together in the holy bonds of matrimony. How romance ran on merrily, like the brook, scoring age, creeds, nationality and wealth.

The Marriage License Bureau is transferring the poor old City Hall. It is the beginning of the end of the old structure. True, it may go on perhaps for years as the official home of the Mayor and the President of the Board of Aldermen, but the City Hall is not what it used to be.
