

PANAMA CANAL OPENS FOR TRAFFIC SATURDAY

Steamer Ancon Will Make Official Trial Trip—Everything in Order for Start.

WASHINGTON, Aug. 13.—The first steamship to pass through the Panama Canal—the Cristobal—made the trip from the Atlantic to the Pacific in eleven and a half hours. The return trip, however, was made in eight and a half hours, which probably marks the average time that will be consumed by merchantmen when all of the machinery of the canal is in smooth operation. The Cristobal made this experimental voyage Aug. 3 and 4 and at the time was drawing 25 feet of water. "Law" Sunday Gov. Goethals, in recognition of their services, allowed a number of their old employees to traverse the canal from ocean to ocean on the steamer Advance, and it is reported that everything is in perfect order for the formal opening of the canal next Saturday, when the Ancon, sister ship to the Cristobal, belonging to the Panama Canal Railway Company and of 9,606 tons, will make the official trial trip.
