

MORGAN OFFERS TO SELL ALASKAN ROAD TO GOVERNMENT

Property Intended for Use in Connection With Railway U. S. Is to Buy.

WASHINGTON, Oct. 13.—An offer to sell or lease the Copper River and Northwestern Railroad to the Government for use in connection with the railway the Government is preparing to build in Alaska was made to-day by J. Pierpont Morgan to Secretary Lane of the Interior Department.

The Secretary replied that pending a report from the Board of Engineers now surveying proposed routes in the Territory he was unable to consider any proposition for acquisition of existing lines.

SOUTHERN RAILROAD NOW CONTROLLED BY SOUTH

Directors Elected to Take Gary's and Baker's Places All From Below Line.

The announcement issued by the road's representatives here reads in part as follows: "Mr. Steele succeeds himself, the four new directors filling vacancies caused by the death of W. W. Finley and H. C. Farnsworth, the resignation of George F. Baker Jr. of New York, and the declaration of Judge M. H. Gary of New York to accept re-election. Judge Gary, who is Chairman of the Board of the United States Steel Corporation, and Mr. Baker, who is allied with a number of other corporations, are retiring from the Board of Directors of the Southern Railway largely in deference to public opinion of the present day in regard to interlocking directorates.

CHICAGO WHEAT AND CORN MARKET.

Wheat opened firm on limited offerings. Selling by elevator elevators, houses checked the advance. The market turned dull and closed with net advances of 1/4 of a cent.

ITEMS FOR INVESTORS.

Special Committee of Five of the Stock Exchange ruled that members wishing to buy or sell listed guaranteed stocks at closing prices of July 30 or at moderate concessions therefrom must submit their proposed transactions in writing to committee.

Misouri Pacific earnings from July 1 declined \$300,210.

New York State trust companies' deposits decreased \$113,341,911 between June 30 and Sept. 1. Total resources decreased \$27,491,590. Loans secured increased \$9,000,000. Unsecured loans decreased \$17,000,000.

New Haven's August gross declined \$411,377; net decreased \$124,432. Two months' gross declined \$459,540; net decreased \$119,744. Surplus after charges decreased \$295,323.

Erie system's surplus for the year, after charges, \$1,422,975. Decline, \$62,700 from previous year. Surplus, after deductions for sinking and reserve funds, \$62,296, is equal to 1.28 per cent. on first preferred stock as compared with 10.3-10 per cent. earned last year.

Southern Railway for year, total income declined \$1,643,321. Surplus, after charges, decreased \$2,238,915. Balance of \$2,139,706, equivalent to 1.28 per cent. on common stock, against 4.33 per cent. on same stock last year.

First week of October gross decreased \$245,968. From July 1 gross declined \$353,461.

Cheapeake and Ohio, first week in October, gross increased, \$1,692. From July 1, increase totals, \$792,506.

U. S. CONVOY FOR CECILIE. WASHINGTON, Oct. 13.—Acting Secretary Roosevelt said to-day that the treasure ship Kronprinzessin Cecilie, under command of Captain Me. would be moved to Boston when permission had been given by the United States District Court of Maine for the transfer of the vessel to the jurisdiction of the District Court of Massachusetts in connection with a recent suit pending against the vessel.

WASHINGTON HEIGHTS HOSPITAL FIGHT IN COURT

Ousted Directors Demand That They Be Reinstated on Board.

The fight among the directors of the Washington Heights Hospital over the use of \$20,000 to meet current expenses when the money was raised for building purposes reached the Supreme Court to-day, when Ledyard Avery, Henry A. Blumenthal and Marcus J. Blumenthal, ousted directors, obtained a writ of mandamus from Justice Donnelly.

The writ directs the officers now in control to show cause why the three directors should not be reinstated. Attorney Henry Louis, who obtained the writ, said to-day that copies were served upon the hospital authorities immediately after Justice Donnelly granted it, and that Messrs. Blumenthal and Avery demanded that they be permitted to inspect the books and papers in the office. This demand was met with a refusal, the lawyer said.

"Unless my clients are permitted to inspect the books," said the lawyer, "I shall move to have certain directors punished for contempt of court."
