

ACCUSED OF CHECK FORGERY
 Abrams Arrested in Street on Charge of Fidelity Trust.
 Charged with forgery, Jacob Abrams of No. 131 West One Hundred and Seventeenth Street was arrested at One

Hundred and Sixteenth Street and Lenox Avenue last evening on complaint of a private detective agency, acting for the Fidelity Trust Company, at Hudson and Chambers Streets.
 It is alleged that Abrams, Oct. 22, presented a forged check for \$1,350 at the bank. He represented that he

wanted to open an account and asked to draw out \$400. The check was drawn on the Mutual Alliance Trust Company, and signed with the name of Isidor Simon, a depositor in that company.
 Abrams got \$25 and was told to return next day for the balance of the \$400. Next day the check proved to be a forgery.

LUNATIC IS LOCKED UP AFTER PATCHOGUE FIRE
 Prisoner Found Near One of Burned Structures When Four Have Been Destroyed.
 Part of the business section of Patchogue, L. I., was wiped out by fire early to-day.
 Only swift work by the volunteer firemen, who were hampered for a time by low water pressure, saved the big lace mills and the West Lake Hotel. The loss amounted to \$40,000. The cafe and liquor store of Joseph Farlazzo, in West Main Street, and three adjoining buildings, burned.
 Constable Rowland has arrested Richard Callahan, a violent lunatic who escaped two weeks ago from the State Hospital at Central Islip and has locked him up pending the arrival of Doc. Sullivan, who was found asleep in a barn back of the burned buildings. He said that he knew nothing of the fire until he heard the firemen shouting.
 But it is recalled that Sullivan, when at Bayport a week ago—he has been wandering along the North Shore, free from any active pursuit by the hospital authorities—admitted starting the fire which destroyed the forist shop of Joseph Chevallit. Because of his huge frame and his ugly temper nobody made an attempt to detain him at that time.

 PARIS, Nov. 17.—The betrothal was announced in Paris to-day of Beatie Van Vorst, the American authoress, and Hughes Leroux, one of the editors of Le Matin. The wedding will take place Dec. 24.
