**EVENING WORLD IS  
PRAISED FOR FIGHT  
ON 'DEATH CURVE'**

Residents of Laurel Hill Say  
Publicity Has Helped  
Remedy Conditions.

"The people of Laurel Hill, L. I., are thankful to The Evening World for helping them escape further slaughter along the Long Island Railroad tracks which skirt the north shore of Newtown Creek at the southern end of this village. The publication of the facts about the deathtrap extending along more than a mile and a half of track has already done wonders for us in arousing public sentiment and in bringing the owners of the big factories to our aid." This was said to-day by A. L. Mor-

ton, a business man of Hobson avenue and a lifelong resident of "The Hill."  
"We hope," he continued, "to have very soon a wide, cinder covered walk alongside the railroad track, but not touching it at any point, so the three or four thousand men and women who pass every day between Maspeth and Penny Bridge can go to and from work without danger of being hit by the trains. The promise of such a safe sidewalk was made to our Village Improvement Association at a meeting a few evenings ago and we feel it will be kept. James Fitzpatrick, manager for the Nichols Copper Company, made the offer on behalf of his concern, and the other companies along the track are to join in the plan. We feel The Evening World, by calling attention to the awful conditions after three girls were killed on the track last week, has done more than any other influence to stop the killing of people."  
**COMPANIES TO BUILD WALK AT OWN EXPENSE.**

"Of course, the \$20,000 appropriated by the old town of Newtown before our consolidation into Greater New York to build a street from Maspeth to what is now Hobson avenue, Laurel Hill, is still in the treasury of New York City. That street alongside the tracks would provide a safe

means of travel on foot, but heaven only knows when we'll be able to get the street through, and in the meantime the broad walk the companies offer to put through, at their own expense and on their own ground, will be the means of saving hundreds of lives. For that we thank The Evening World."  
"We feel indebted to The Evening World," said Patrick Reilly, President of the Laurel Hill Improvement Association. "The publication of the facts, the story of the killing of hundreds of helpless people along the 'rails of Death Curve' and 'Slaughter House Cut' gave the alarm and brought us help quickly. Mr. Fitzpatrick, representing the Nichols Copper Company, has not only joined our association, but he has been made a member of the Executive Committee. We give great credit to him and his company for giving the land for the safety path, fully half a mile, from their works to Penny Bridge. And we can never forget the prompt action of The Evening World in calling attention to the dangers. With the aid of the companies we expect soon to see the last of the deathtrap."  
A series of hold-ups of employees of the National Enameling Company reported to have taken place late Wednesday night and early yesterday morning shows the need of read-

er access to the streets in the neighborhood. At present the only means of entry east and west is along the railroad tracks. It is as difficult for a mounted policeman to get in there as it would be to get into the Park Avenue tunnel in New York—harder, in fact. And the patrolling in all this part of the Two Hundred and Seventy-fifth Precinct is done by mounted men.


**STREET WOULD HAVE PREVENTED FIVE ROBBERIES.**

The National Enameling Company is working its men three eight-hour shifts at present. Wednesday was pay day. When the night shift went off duty, a little before midnight, most of the

men went away in groups, and so escaped molestation; but at least five of the late starters were robbed after midnight by a gang of half a dozen thugs. These men were caught one at a time, black-jacked, rolled off the tracks and robbed. Not only were their pay envelopes taken from them, but their watches, and in several cases even their shoes. One or two, who began to look around for some trace of their assailants, were quickly beaten and run out of the neighborhood. Detectives from the police station at Hunter's Point are trying to find the highwaymen; but the chances of success seem very small. If there was a street along the line—for which the citizens long ago paid—these robberies could not occur, for proper lighting and police patrolling would make them impossible.
