Paris Claims That Some of the Trenches Have Been Regained—Grand Duke of Wurtemberg Heads Germans.

A gain of three miles east of Ypres is reported today in the despatches from Berlin, and the prediction is made in the German capital that the allies will not be able to hold the town for another week. Both Paris and London admit that the British were forced to give up part of Hill 60, but the Paris War Office says some of the lost trenches were regained.

BERLIN (via London), May 6 (Associated Press).—The situation at Ypres, Belgium, where the Grand Duke of Wurtemberg is commanding, is considered promising for the Germans. It is believed here that the British and French will not be able to hold the town of Ypres for another week.

FOUR U. S. SUBMARINES HERE FOR MANOEUVRES

WEIGHTED BODY FOUND.

JAP ULTIMATUM SAYS CHINA MUST YIELD TO DEMANDS

Note Fixes Sunday at 6 P. M. as Time Limit for Giving in Unconditionally.

TOKIO, May 6.—Official announcement was made here this afternoon that Japan had sent an ultimatum to China. Japan gives China until Sunday at 6 P. M. to accede to her demands, which virtually give Japan control over China's internal affairs. The ultimatum implied that force would be used by Japan if China's reply was unsatisfactory.

RELIEF SHIP WAS SUNK

LONDON, May 6.—The British steamship Harpalyce, under charter to the American-Belgian Relief Committee, which was sunk by a German submarine in the North Sea the early part of April, was torpedoed within twenty-three miles of the Dutch coast, according to a report made to the British Admiralty after an investigation which was confined chiefly to an examination of the members of the crew of the steamer, for the reason that no part of the ship remained afloat.

MRS. MURRAY PROSTRATED WHEN SHE GETS LETTER.

The arrest of Carlson followed a few hours after the homicidal pervert who has sent several threatening and obscene letters to the mother of little Leonore Cohn, who was killed and mutilated on March 29, intruded on the sacred sorrow of Mrs. Murray, little Charlie's mother, with a letter saying that it was no use to try to apprehend him for killing her child, and that as soon as the excitement attending the murder had cooled down he would kill another one.
