COMMITTS SUICIDE IN CELL AWAITING MURDER SENTENCE

Joseph Frick, fifty-nine years old, who was to have been sentenced to the Kings County Superior Court to-day for killing his son Otto, committed suicide between 1 and 2:30 o'clock by hanging himself with his leather belt to a crossbar of his cell in the Raymond Street Jail.

He had been dependent since his conviction last Friday, but seemed to be sleeping when Keeper Michael Keating passed his cell at 5 o'clock. The keepers make tours every thirty minutes, and the next time Keating came around Frick was dead. Dr. Ferguson was called from Brooklyns Hospital and issued the official certificate.

17 PRISONERS ESCAPE THROUGH JAIL WALLS; INNOCENT MAN KILLED
