TELLS OF FLIGHTS IN GIANT BIPLANE CARRYING 16 MEN

Russian Aviator, Here From Front, Says Machines Lift 3 Tons of Ammunition.

The Adriatic, of the White Star Line, arrived this morning with the news that Liverpool, her port of departure, is now as dark as London or any of the other east coast cities which live in constant danger of Zeppelin attacks.

Capt. Eugen Vetchoren, of the Russian flying corps, arrived on the Adriatic with messages for the Russian Embassy at Washington.

These big biplanes are a Russian development of the Wright machine. They weigh about four tons altogether.

Each one carries three pilots, four engines, six gunners—two to a gun—and three helpers. The largest shell we carried weighed half a ton.

It was about six feet long and as large around as a man's body. With that kind of explosive, we blew up fortifications on the German frontier and did a great deal of other damage.

Payne Barnes of Washington, D. C., and William Frey of Boston, two youths of seventeen, who went abroad on a horse-bus fourteen months ago and enlisted in the Royal Horse Artillery, returned in the third cabin of the Adriatic on hearing of the trouble in Mexico.

Frey and Barnes had no difficulty in securing their release from service when they let it be known they were Americans and minors.
