

PLAN IN SECRET TO GUARD CITY IF BREAK COMES

State Military Authorities and Police Prepare to Take Extraordinary Steps.

White House Police Commissioner Arthur Woods has Major Tom, John E. O'Hara, commander of the State National Guard, would discuss today their conference with the White House, it is known they talked over in Albany, the extraordinary measures to be taken by the State military authorities and the New York police in case of a break with Germany.

It is not known how rapidly preparations in such a contingency, but it is apparent that no chance is to be taken. They know what a severe destruction of even a small section of the subway, damage to the river tubes, or even a rumor of an attempt to cripple the city's light facilities or water supply would cause. They realize the possibility of bomb outrages on the water front which would seriously hamper commerce. So, to reassure the inhabitants in case of trouble, they are understood to be ready to act immediately on a "Safety Plan," said to have been outlined to the Governor as follows:

1. An immediate calling out of the State's National Guard, either in its full strength or in numbers sufficient to cope with any critical situation anticipated.
2. Employment of the available men in New York Police Department to supplement the guard in the work that had been mapped out for it.
3. Assigning sections of the State soldiery to patrol the piers and water front of New York City, guard the city's gas and electric plants, to picket duty at the city's reservoirs and protect its waterheds.
4. Detaining as many of the city police as are available to guard the subways, river tubes, city buildings and other places which might be imperilled by attack not in sympathy with the possible action of the President and Congress.

Early in the year Commissioner Woods prepared a set of riot plans. Under his direction the Chief Inspector's staff cooperating with Inspector Cohen, completed a survey of the natural resources of the city. The report to Commissioner Woods contained information relative to river craft; motor vehicles that can be pressed into service; grounds available for camps; police stations and training centers; empty buildings; horses and other mounts obtainable; a census of the foreign population arranged in districts according to importance and likelihood of trouble due to race riots; organization of citizens for riot duty; methods of handling volunteers; lists of police officers, and systems dealing with the transportation and equipment of large bodies of men.

In addition to these steps in municipal preparedness, the plan to form a civilian police corps was adopted and is well under way. Commissioner Woods has a long list of names and addresses of other volunteers who can take the place of the regular police in different precincts in case of dangerous riots. And under the plan it is estimated the entire regular police force can be mobilized in one hour.

Speaking yesterday afternoon at the Yale Club, the meeting of the Executive Committee of the Citizens' Preparedness Parade, Police Commissioner Woods said: "We have arranged to take in case the bridges connecting Brooklyn and Manhattan should be destroyed by any cause whatsoever, we should be able to find every available boat within fifty miles, and establish an improvised ferry service. Another thing we are doing is to provide pistol practice for police under the instruction of army officers."

Fifteen detectives attached to Police Headquarters late yesterday afternoon were stationed at the aqueduct gates at Mount Kisco, Poughkeepsie, Ardsley and Dunwoodie. The men will be on duty pending further instructions from Deputy Police Commissioner Lord.
